## Health and Safety Plan for SBPLI 2022 FRC Regional Events

Event Length	<b>Standard 3-Day Regional</b>
Public Attendance	<b>No spectators will be allowed entry to reduce the number of people in the arena.</b>
Vaccination Requirements	<b>SBPLI will require all volunteers to be fully vaccinated. Participants (coaches, team members, etc.) to show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test within the prior 72 hours to gain entry.</b>
Face Masks	<b>All participants will be required to wear masks Masks must be tight fitting and worn properly, fully covering the nose and mouth. Due to the relatively long nature of our event, N95 and KN95 masks are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.</b>
Team Size Limitations	<b>24 members per team (includes students, mentors, and coaches) allowed onsite. All team members (students, mentors, and coaches) must be registered on the Team Roster in the FIRST Team Information System. The same set of team members do not have to attend all days. At the beginning of each competition day, a single set of substitutions can be made. Once the competition starts, no further substitutions can be made.</b>
Food	<b>Food is to be eaten in designated areas only. Food may not be eaten in the stands or the pits.</b>
Safety Glasses	<b>Teams will be responsible for bringing and providing safety glasses for everyone on their roster. A small number of safety glasses will be made available to volunteers for duration of the event.</b>
Cleaning and Sanitation	<b>Field cleaning will occur prior to the start of each event day and throughout the day as necessary. Sanitizing wipes will be located in each driver station for team use. Hand sanitizer stands will be set up throughout the event</b>
Pit Area and Spacing	<b>Accommodations will be made to isolate pits and provide spacing at scoring table and in stands.</b>
Monitoring	<b>Team safety officers to help monitor team compliance with this plan.</b>
Judging	<b>Dean's List judging done remotely in advance of the event; all other judging done live during event.</b>

NOTE: If conditions change significantly as we approach the dates of the events, SBPLI retains the right to adjust this plan accordingly.
